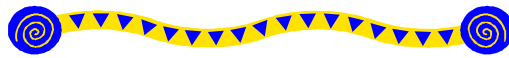




RAMSGATE & BROADSTAIRS ROYAL AIR FORCE ASSOCIATION NEWSLETTER

I then moved to Farnborough Village and went to 2427 (Biggin Hill)

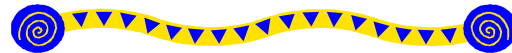
Squadron. I recently moved back to
